RAINWATER FALLING ON THE ROADWAY WILL BE COLLECTED AND
INFILTRATED IN ADJACENT ECOLOGICALLY ENGINEERED INFILTRATION
GALLERIES. THE ROADWAY, SLOPED TO ONE SIDE, IS SHOWN WITH A
VEGETATED SHOULDER, THE FIRST COMPONENT IN THE DESIGN. EXCESS
RUNOFF NOT INFILTRATED IN THE SHOULDER WILL BE COLLECTED IN
CATCH BASINS AND TRANSPORTED VIA CULVERT UNDER THE ROADWAY TO
A DIKED INFILTRATION AREA LOCATED ON THE DOWN SLOPE SIDE. THIS
FORESTED INFILTRATION AREA CONSISTS OF BOTH WETLAND AND UPLAND
HABITATS.
